

GIFT AID

Gift Aid is a scheme that allows any charity to claim a refund of tax which a donor has paid on a sum subscribed or donated. You must have paid sufficient tax to cover the refund we shall be claiming; the tax can be on income, investments, saving or capital gains. The completed information is required by the Inland Revenue as your declaration that you wish The Society of Bookbinders to recover the tax.

Gift Aid adds a bonus to any money that you give to The Society of Bookbinders. If you are a UK tax payer then, for the standard subscription of £36.00, we can claim £10.08.

As your declaration covers subscriptions and donations:

- Please notify the Society if you change your name or address while the declaration is in force.
- You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the Society: it will not apply to donations or subscriptions that you make after the cancellation.

If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax, you should cancel the declaration. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your self-assessment tax return.
