

Boekje Geluk. Little Book of Happiness



This is an adaptation of the “Turning Triangle” of Carmencho Arregui

Method:

Cover: Paper of 100gr-120gr, short side 148 mm, long side 210 mm

Score and cut all lines as follows:

Place the paper against the ruler and set square

Put ruler and triangle at 78 mm

Score from top to bottom and leave the ruler in place

With a small awl put a mark at 69 mm, 135 mm and 140 mm

Cut from top to 69 mm (A) and from 135 mm to bottom (B)

Move the triangle and ruler along the set square up to 112 mm

Mark the 102 mm point with an awl

Score line D and cut line C to form the small triangle

Now turn the page so the triangle point upwards

Score line E at 68 mm and F at 140 mm

Fold E and F and check

Open up, fold G and open up again

Turn the triangle to the inside and mountain fold D will fall into place automatically

The text “boekje” is now underneath and can’t be seen

The paper now looks like a cross

Rub fold D down only after checking that H and F are lined up properly

The cross has 4 right-angled corners

Fold I and J: score G and K parallel to the edges of the “cover”

Everything should now line up

Now close up along all valley folds and check

Open up again and attach the little booklet with a pamphlet stitch
